

Friends of Bristol Eye Hospital support the staff and patients of the Bristol Eye Hospital. Since 1977 the Friends have made grants of £1.4m to benefit the treatment, comfort and care of patients and to improve staff amenities.

Treatment for all patients has been greatly enhanced by our support.



We pay a variety of grants providing:

- highly specialised medical equipment enabling consultants, surgeons and nurses to use the very latest technology
- comforts for patients such as drinks trolleys, an aquarium for the children's ward, wheelchairs, lounge chairs, plants around the hospital
- amenities for staff such as modern kitchens, showers and garden chairs

We only give grants for items that the NHS cannot afford; we give priority to items which:

- help the hospital to maintain its international reputation as a pioneer in ophthalmic practice
- make a big difference to patients with serious conditions
- enable more patients to be treated more quickly and comfortably



In 2019 Friends of Bristol Eye Hospital and Above & Beyond jointly purchased a Forus Neo wide-angled retinal camera to help hospital staff diagnose early eye problems in babies and young children to help prevent them from losing their sight

Data Privacy

We will cease communication with you and/or remove your data from our records within one month of receiving a written request from you. You are entitled to ask us at any time what data we hold for you and/or ask us to amend or delete it.
